

BOOK OF REVELATION: STUDY # 11 – The Temple, Two Witnesses and Seventh Trumpet (Revelation 11)

Key Verse: “And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothes in sackcloth.” (11:3)

Theme: “And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdom of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever.” (11:15)

A. God has staked His name on one nation – Israel Jer. 31:1-2

B. God has also chosen a city to associate with – Jerusalem

C. God has also chosen a place to dwell with His people – the Temple

D. God says there will be another temple. Rev. 11:1-2

II. God Protects His Own (Rev. 11:3-7)

A. God always has a plan.

B. God always has a witness.

C. Who are the two witnesses?

1. Zerubabel and Joshua (Zech. 4)?
2. Enoch and Elijah because neither saw death?
3. Moses and Elijah? Most likely
 - a. Transfiguration Matt. 17
 - b. Position in God's plan Moses (law) Elijah (prophets)
 - c. Power in ministry Moses (plagues) Elijah (drought & miracles)
 - d. Strong prophecy in Malachi 3:3 and 4:5-6

D. God protects his own until he is finished with them.

III. God Gives Endless Life (Rev. 11:8-14)

A. Abraham's faith - Romans 4:17

B. God's promise - Romans 8:11

C. God's signals (quake at end of 6th seal, 7th trumpet, 7th vial) ending something. What ending in 11:13?

IV. God Expects Worship (Rev. 11:15-19)

A. Heaven is a place of worship where God rules and reigns

B. Worship flows out of the wonders of God's revealing Himself.

1. He reveals His Power
2. He reveals His Plan
3. He reveals His Promise
4. He reveals His Punishment

God keeps His word – Are we trusting Him?

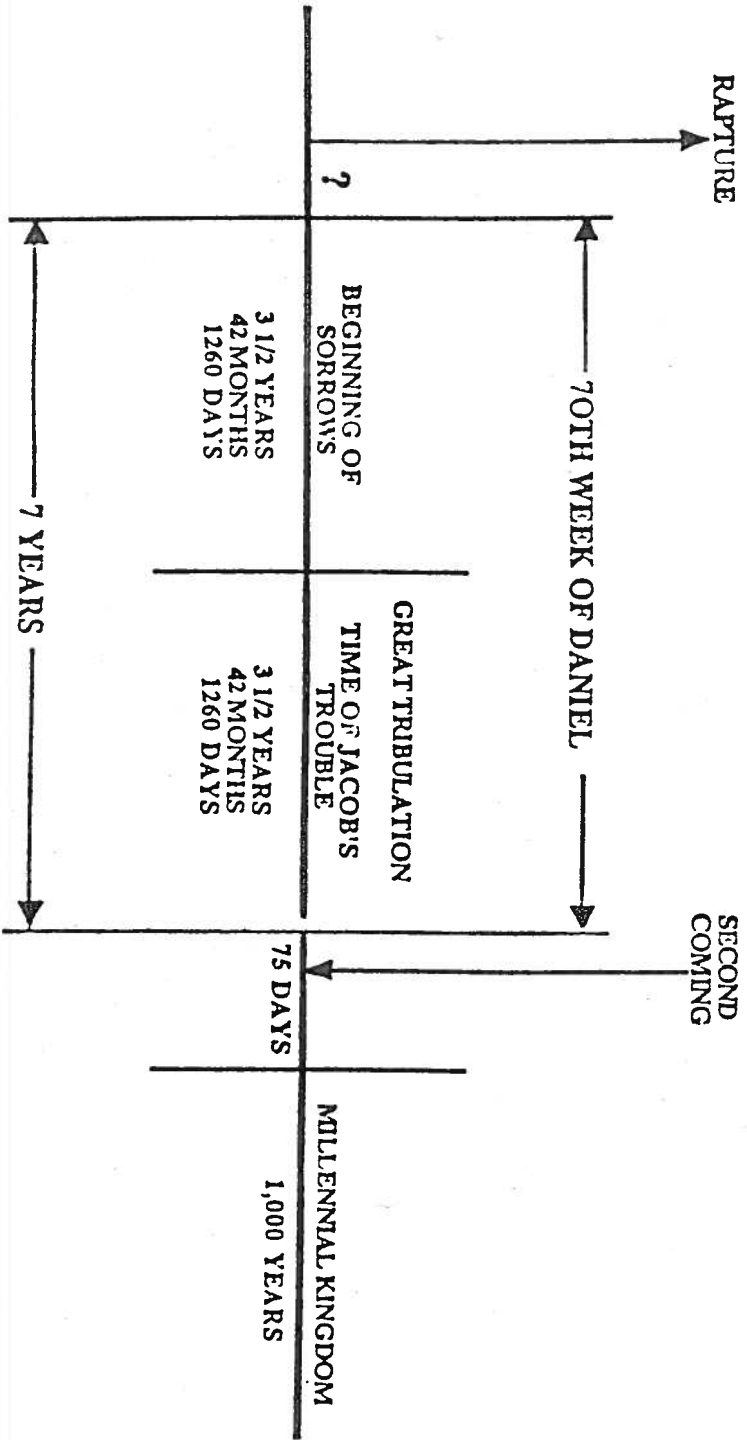
God protects His own – Are we resting in Him?
